The region's Workforce Career Centers have a team of highly skilled, professional Business Service Representatives who are committed to helping you recruit and retain a quality workforce. Coordinated by the West Piedmont Workforce Investment Board, this team provides a variety of services to help you with all of your workforce, human resource needs. ***We provide information on free services for recruitment, training and incentives.***

What we do...

- **Targeted Recruitments** – offering you an employer- or industry-specific job fair focused on a job title, occupation, or set of skills.
- **Assessments** – testing your potential or current employees for their workplace skills based on your requirements.
- **Referrals to Partnering Agencies** – helping you in finding the right agency to help meet your workforce needs.
- **Skills Development** – upgrading the skills of your new hires and for those workers that have been with your company for any period of time.
- **Human Resource Services** – helping your company gain information on compensation, hiring, safety, wellness, benefits, employee motivation, communication, administration, and training.
- **Available Space** – conducting interviews and training at one of our conveniently located Workforce Career Centers or agency partner within the network.
- **Job Listing** – assisting you in searching for qualified workers based on specific job requirements by listing your job postings throughout our network.
- **Labor Market Information** – garnering wage and salary data, occupational projections, and other employment statistics.

How we do it...

- **On-the-Job Training** – training potential new hires with a commitment to hire at the end. Subsidy of up to 50 percent of the wages is available if certain requirements are met.
- **Incumbent Worker/Customized Training** – training new or current employees in classroom based training. 50 percent of the training may be subsidized if certain requirements are met.
- **Internship or Work Experience** – providing opportunities for you to get to know a potential employee and for the potential worker to learn more about your industry. Wages are paid by the Workforce Career Center (One Stop) Operator for a limited period of time.
- **Workshops** – offering standard and customized workshop sessions that provide information to upgrade skills such as customer service and other transferable skills within a workplace.
